COMMUNITY FIRST RESPONDER Meeting, 12 December 2022, 8pm, Corlough Community Centre. Community First Responders (CFR) are volunteers who are trained to attend certain types of emergency calls in the area where they live or work. Their aim is to reach a potential life threatening emergency in the first vital minutes before the ambulance crew arrives. Their role is to help stabilise the patient and provide the appropriate care including CPR & defibrillation, until the more highly skilled ambulance crew arrives on scene to take over the treatment. Training is provided locally with each scheme providing initial CFR certification and regular ongoing training. A member of the Ambulance Service will attend on the night and give a presentation on this service and advise on how we could establish this in our parish.
