Blessing of the Graves 2025

Sincere thank you to all those who assisted last Sunday at the Blessing of the Graves, which were very well attended. Next Sunday, the Blessing of the Graves will take place after the 12.30pm Mass in St Patrick’s Church, Corlough. The Mass will be streamed on ChurchTV for those who cannot attend. The Pastoral Council would like to invite you to cross over to St Patrick’s N.S. where light refreshments will be served afterwards. There will be a collection for the ongoing upkeep and maintenance of the cemetery.

Jubilee Mass for the Sick will be celebrated on Sunday, the 17th of August at 11am. We will gather as a parish community on the feast of Our Lady of Knock to invoke her intercession for the sick of the parish and the Anointing of the Sick will be offered at the Mass.

Jubilee Year Mass on St Mogue's Island, Bawnboy, Co. Cavan: Bishop Martin Hayes will celebrate a special Jubilee Year Mass on the Bank Holiday Monday, the 4th of August 2025 at 3.00pm. Archbishop Francis Duffy and the priests of the diocese will concelebrate. There will be a short Camino-style walk beforehand from the grounds of the former Wonderland Ballroom (H14 HH50) and the Blessing of the Graves will take place afterwards. A coffee cart will be at the shore from 12 noon and toilet facilities will be provided. Due to the expected crowd, please allow enough time to walk to the shore and be transported across by boat to the island. We would encourage people to park at the Wonderland Ballroom and take part in the Camino walk but a shuttle bus will also be in operation from 1pm-5pm. The Mass will be transmitted to the shore for those who would like to participate but would rather not cross over to the island. This event is being organised in conjunction with the Bawnboy Community Festival and all proceeds of the collection will go towards cancer charities and other local organisations. A warm invitation is extended to people across the diocese to this Jubilee Year of Hope event in honour of St Maedhóg, who was born on the island around the year 558 A.D..

Kilmore Diocesan Jubilee Year of Hope Pilgrimage to Knock Shrine will take place on Saturday, 9th of August, the Feast of St Felim, the Patron Saint of the Diocese. Mass will be celebrated at 3pm by Bishop Martin Hayes. The Anointing of the Sick will be offered at the Mass. The Stations of the Cross and Rosary will take place outdoors at 2pm. The choir from the Church of the Immaculate Conception, Belturbet, will provide the Sacred Music, while people from the Parish of Annagh will participate in the liturgy. Knock Shrine, is one of the three designated national pilgrimage sites for the Jubilee Year, along with Lough Derg and Croagh Patrick and so people throughout the diocese are cordially invited to participate in the annual pilgrimage, especially during this Jubilee Year of Hope. Diocesan Jubilee Year of Hope Pilgrimage to Rome - Bishop Martin Hayes will lead a diocesan pilgrimage to Rome from Thursday 20 to Wednesday 26 November 2025 to mark the Jubilee Year of Hope. This pilgrimage will be of particular interest (though not exclusively) to those involved with church choirs as it will coincide with the Jubilee of Choirs being organised as part of the Jubilee Year of Hope programme in the Vatican. The cost of the pilgrimage is €1,855 per person sharing on a half-board basis.
