## Plenary Indulgence of 2 November

From 12 noon on 1 November until midnight on 2 November one plenary indulgence (applicable only to the Holy Souls) may be gained by visiting a church or oratory and recite the Our Father and the Creed there. Conditions for gaining a plenary indulgence: Go to Confession (in the week preceding or the week following 1 November). Receive Holy Communion (1 Holy Communion for each indulgence). Pray for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father, and Hail Mary or any other prayer of one's choice).

1-8 November: The faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead, may gain a plenary indulgence (applicable only to the Holy Souls) once per day from 1 to 8 November. The above conditions regarding Confession, Holy Communion and prayer for the Pope's intentions apply also for this.
