Proposed Works at St Mogue's Church, Bawnboy

Extensive Restoration Works will commence at St Mogue's Church, Bawnboy on Monday, the 16th February 2026. P. McGovern and Son will be the main contractor. The works include a new heating system, lighting, flooring, windows, doors, tarmacadam, landscaping, accessible toilet, art work and altar furniture. Irish Contract Seating, a company that specialises in church furniture, will remove the pews tomorrow for refurbishment. The Church will be closed from tomorrow, the 16th February, for several weeks while the works are being carried out. Christenings, Funerals and other ceremonies will have to take place elsewhere for the duration of the works. Two weekend Masses will be celebrated in the parish from the First Sunday of Lent (next weekend) until the internal works are completed:

Saturday - St Patrick's Church, Corlough - 8.15pm.

Sunday - St Patrick's Church, Kilnavart - 9.30am.

The Parish Pastoral Council would like to apologise for any inconvenience that the closure may cause.

As today's Mass is the last Mass celebrated in St Mogue's Church until the works are completed, we will mark the occasion with a Mass of thanksgiving. We give thanks to God today for all parishioners, both living and deceased, who have gathered in the church to worship God and celebrate the Sacraments over the last 47 years.
