**North West STEM Fest** From 27–31 July at The Island Theatre, Ballinamore, this festival serves teenagers from across Cavan, Leitrim, Longford, Roscommon, and Sligo, with a particular focus on young people transitioning from primary to secondary school. Through hands-on STEM activities, teamwork, and creative challenges, the programme helps students build confidence, develop problem-solving skills, and form friendships ahead of secondary school in September. We are especially committed to making the event accessible for neurodivergent students and families who may not typically engage with traditional summer programmes.
