Working in conjunction with the National Ambulance Service they respond to emergencies including Heart Attack, Cardiac Arrest, Strokes Choking. The group provides an essential service across Corlough Templeport Swanlinbar Corraleehan and Aughawillan helping to deliver potentially life saving care in those critical first minutes before professional medical assistance arrives. None of us ever know when we or a loved one might need this service. Having trained responders living within our community can make a real difference when every second counts.
