Each bag will contain 2 books, one on the theme of starting school and one on the theme of friendship, and a range of supporting materials for parents. The Irish Language version of the bag will also contain 2 Irish Language books and the same range of supporting materials. Call into the library during opening hours to collect. **C-Pen Reader** The C-Pen is a reader pen which scans and then reads text aloud to help with independent reading. People with dyslexia, aphasia or other reading difficulties may find the C-Pen helpful. People learning languages or those with vision problems may also find these pens useful for home, study or work. The pen reads text aloud with a natural speaking voice. The pens have built-in dictionaries so you can access definitions as you read for better understanding. The C-Pen doesn't store any data. There is no need for an internet or WiFi connection. Ask a member of staff for more information. You can borrow a C-Pen for 3 weeks.
